The Moanoghar Moanoghar Arabinda Chakma and Parul Chakma Memorial Scholarship was formally launched on 26 July 2015 through an official ceremony at Moanoghar, in presence of Mr. Arabina Chakma and his extended family including his eldest son Manas Mukur Chakma. The other endower of the scholarship Ms. Parul Chakma, wife of Arabinda Chakma could not attend due to illness.

The endowments donated by both will be kept in separate bank fixed deposit accounts and the interests will be disbursed to the deserving students every year. The scholarship will be awarded to a student from CHT indigenous minorities for subjects in the field of Engineering & Technology.

Mr. Arabinda Chakma is known across the Chittagong Hill Tracts for his philanthropy and support for education. He is also one of the first entrepreneurs from the indigenous minorities in the region.

The scholarship will be administered as part of Moanoghar's Higher Education Loan Programme. Currently, Moanoghar supports 80 students for tertiary level education. Moanoghar would like to support at least 400 students from the CHT indigenous communities over the next 5 years under HELP.

Khagrachari Hill District Council (K-HDC) Makes a Grant to Tarabunia School, Dighinala

Moanoghar gratefully acknowledges a grant of 1,000,000 (one million) taka to its branch, Tarabunia School in Dighinala, by the Khagrachari Hill District Council (K-HDC). The grant is provided for construction of 2 classrooms of the school.

The Tarabunia School currently receives 90 students from Class VI to VIII from the Tarabunia village and the neghbouring communities. After class VIII, students take admission in Moanoghar for further studies.

The expansion of the 2 classrooms will allow the school to receive more students and as well as to set up a science laboratory in the future.
